

How to use GROUPS to PERSONALIZE your course


A teacher can enable and/or restrict student access to course content according to which GROUPS the students have been placed in. Here's how:

STEP 1: Set up the groups

- 1. **Open** the course
- 2. Go to Administration > Course administration > **Users > Groups** (as follows):



3. On the 'Groups' page, **select** the 'Create group' button:



4. Name the group and add any other necessary information. Click 'Save changes'.


5. On the 'Groups' page, select 'Add/remove users':



- 6. Select students for the group. When done, click 'Back to groups'.
- 7. Continue until all groups have been created.

STEP 2: Set RESTRICTIONS for each section, activity or resource


1. Turn editing on.



- 2. Scroll to the section, activity or resource you wish to restrict.
 - a. For a **section**, click here:



b. For an activity or resource, click 'Edit' next to the chosen item, then select 'Edit settings':



3. On the next screen, scroll to 'Restrict access'. Then click 'Add restriction . . .'

From there, you may choose the restriction, determine the settings, add further restrictions if you wish. Remember to hit **'Save changes'**.
