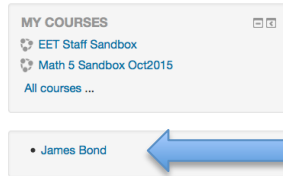

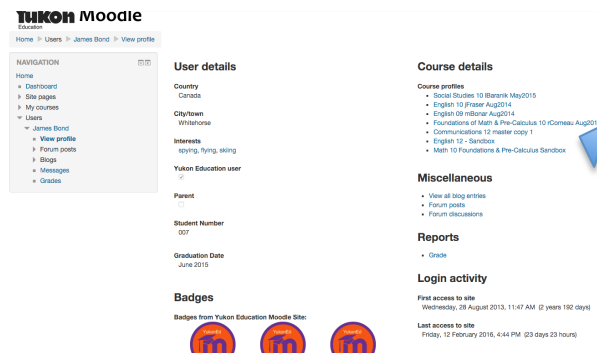

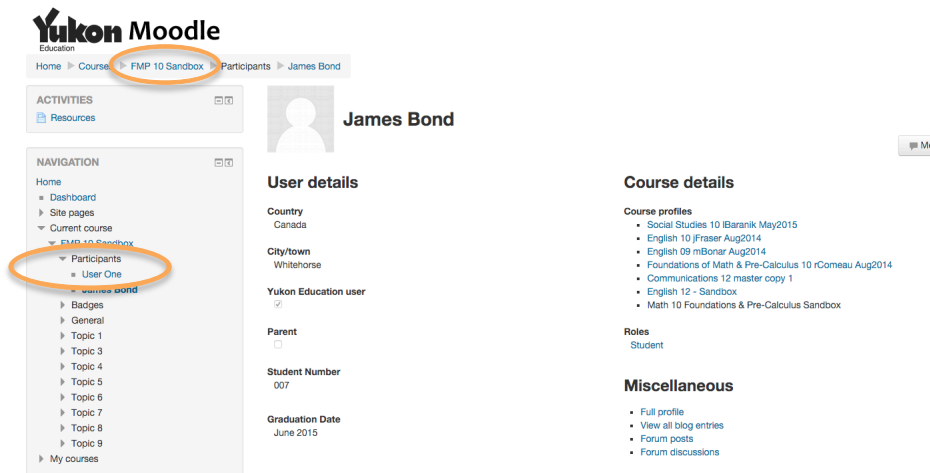
- Click on your child's name and you will be taken to their profile page.
