

Passwords for Moodle Quizzes and Tests

Some quizzes/tests come 'password protected', others don't – that depends on who authored the original course. As teacher, you can decide whether you want to retain the original password or change it – this is at your discretion.

Keep in mind, though, that we must **protect the integrity of Moodle assessment material**. The same content is being used by many other students and teachers, so we are obliged not to give the original passwords out to students and not to allow students to copy and share any of the questions and answers.

Here's how a teacher can discover the embedded passwords:

- Go to the **quiz** itself and **click** on it > go to **Administration** menu > **Quiz administration** > **Edit settings** (*Note: these 'settings' are for the quiz itself, not for the whole course*) > **Extra restrictions on attempts**. Select the '**Unmask**' box to reveal the password.
- **Repeat** for each quiz/test in the course

Once you unmask the password, you can either:

- ❖ **exit** the page **without** making a change, **OR**
- ❖ **reset** the password to one of your own choice and click '**Save**'

It's then up to you how you proceed. You could either:

- enter the password **secretly** for the student or
- if you have changed the password yourself, you could tell it to the student but then **change** it each and every time the quiz is attempted (very time consuming!), or
- simply **remove** the password altogether, allowing open access to the quiz. *Note: there are other ways to restrict access that you may want to explore. Click on the quiz, then go to 'Edit settings > Restrict access' and/or 'Edit settings > Extra restrictions'*
